HEALTH ADVISORY: Mpox & Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever Travel Advisories

December 21, 2023

Dear Colleagues,

We hope this message finds you well.

Benton County is sharing Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) travel advisories related to a Clade I Mpox outbreak associated with Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and a Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever (RMSF) outbreak associated with Tecate, state of Baja California, Mexico. To date, there have been no reports of Clade I Mpox in the United States of America (USA). As of December 8, 2023, five confirmed RMSF cases have been reported in the USA.
