Business

• Co-Chair Hazelwood report on the Situation Table Training hosted by Corvallis Police Department and Benton County Health Department. She attended the 2 day training with many community members to learn about elevated acute risk and how the community can wrap around together and support each other and the people in a way that is supportive and respecting privacy. Director Sands spoke to the efficiency of the Situation Table Meetings, bring multiple community partners together in one room for one meeting, instead of multiple meetings with overlapping groups.

Standing Agenda Items

- Measure 110- Commissioner Augerot
 - Commissioner Augerot spoke about the amount of things happening right now with respect to the future of Measure 110. There is a Joint Interim Committee on Addiction and Community Safety Response that has convened for 2 days. Commissioner Augerot expects some action to occur in the short legislative session. Issues are big and complex and some may not be addressed until the following long legislative session.
 - Joint Interim Committee on Addiction & Community Response has held two informational meetings, the first focused on prevention and treatment, the second primarily on law enforcement. There is a lot of good info, available on

- Representative Charlie Conrad convened on youth behavioral and measure 110 and the effect on the juvenile system that has not been addressed.
- Commissioner Augerot shared that one thing was clarified during the last session was the the Behavioral Health Resource Network (BHRN) grants should be coordinating with the local Public Advisory Committee on Mental Health (MHADDAC) but not how.
- Member Mirza expressed concerns about what has been shared with the public around data, Commissioner Augerot agreed there is a lot of work to be done still.
- Co-Chair Hazelwood spoke to the BHRN grant reporting is now giving more of a clearer picture of the people getting the services than before

- Crisis Center
 - Construction has finally started. All permits are in and now heavy equipment has arrived to begin!
 - Timeline is being reviewed at this time as we had a set back
- House Bill 5202- Damien Sands
 - Director Sands discussed HB4004 funds to help with recruitment and retention. The behavioral health workforce is in high demand and a lot of providers are starting off on their own, and so its been hard to hire for our open positions. We've also had several resignations, people moving back home to be with family, travel, venture out on their own, etc.
