# Health Related Social Needs

## Background

*Oregon's 1115 Waiver includes:*

- Continuous enrollment 0-6
- 2 year enrollment for ages 6 and up
- More coordinated health services, particularly for youth with special healthcare needs
- **Health Related Social Needs (HRSN) for transition populations**
  - Climate Devices
  - Housing Supports
  - Nutrition Supports

# HRSN Eligibility

## HRSN is a 2-tier eligibility benefit

### Transition populations

- Recently eligible for Medicare
- Homeless or at Risk of Homelessness
- Recently released from mental health facility
- Recently released from incarceration
- Involvement in Child Welfare

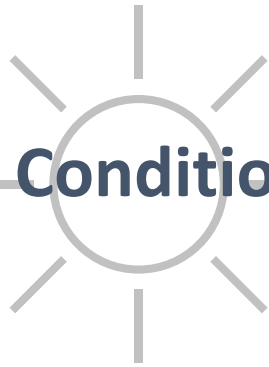
### Medical Need

Eligible diagnoses change based on benefit and request but include things like pregnancy, asthma, hypertension, uncontrolled diabetes, COPD, etc.

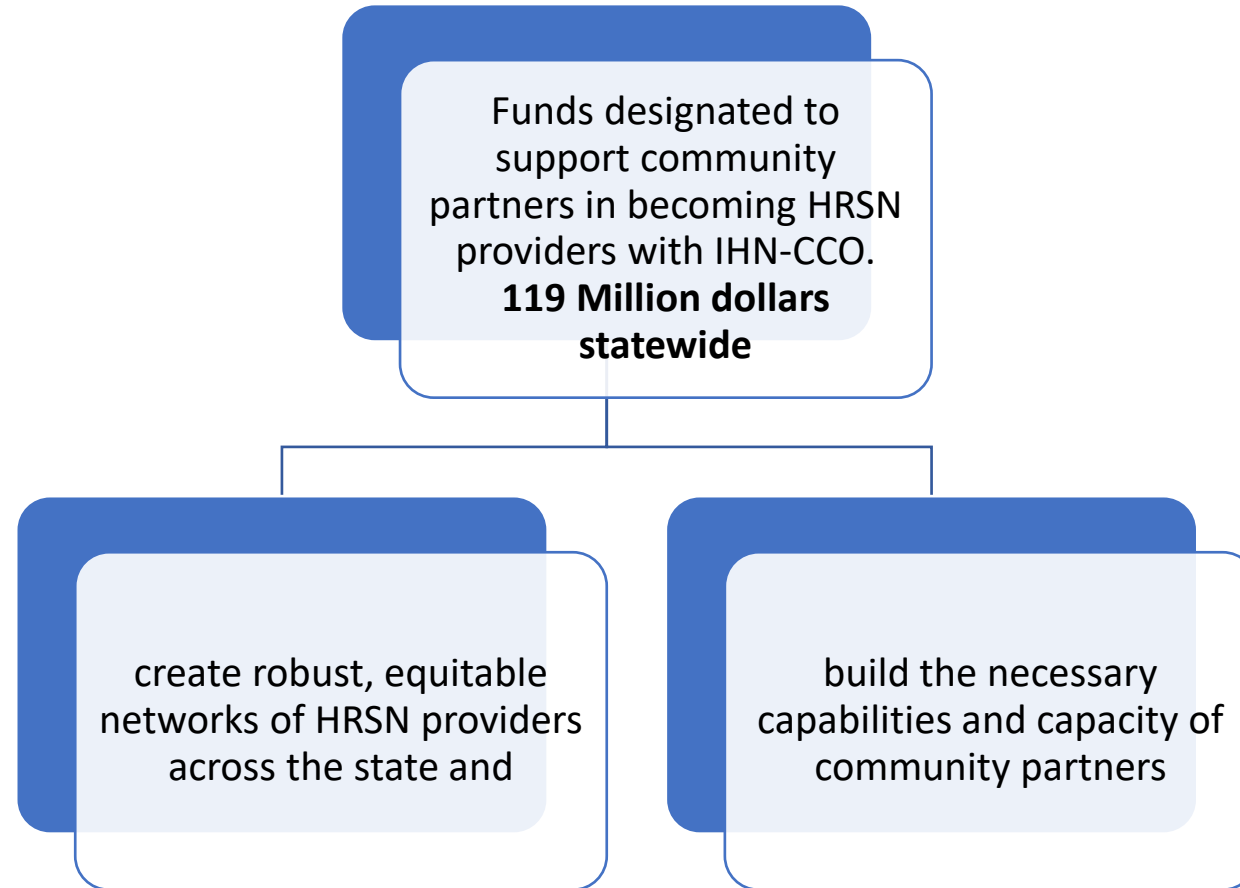

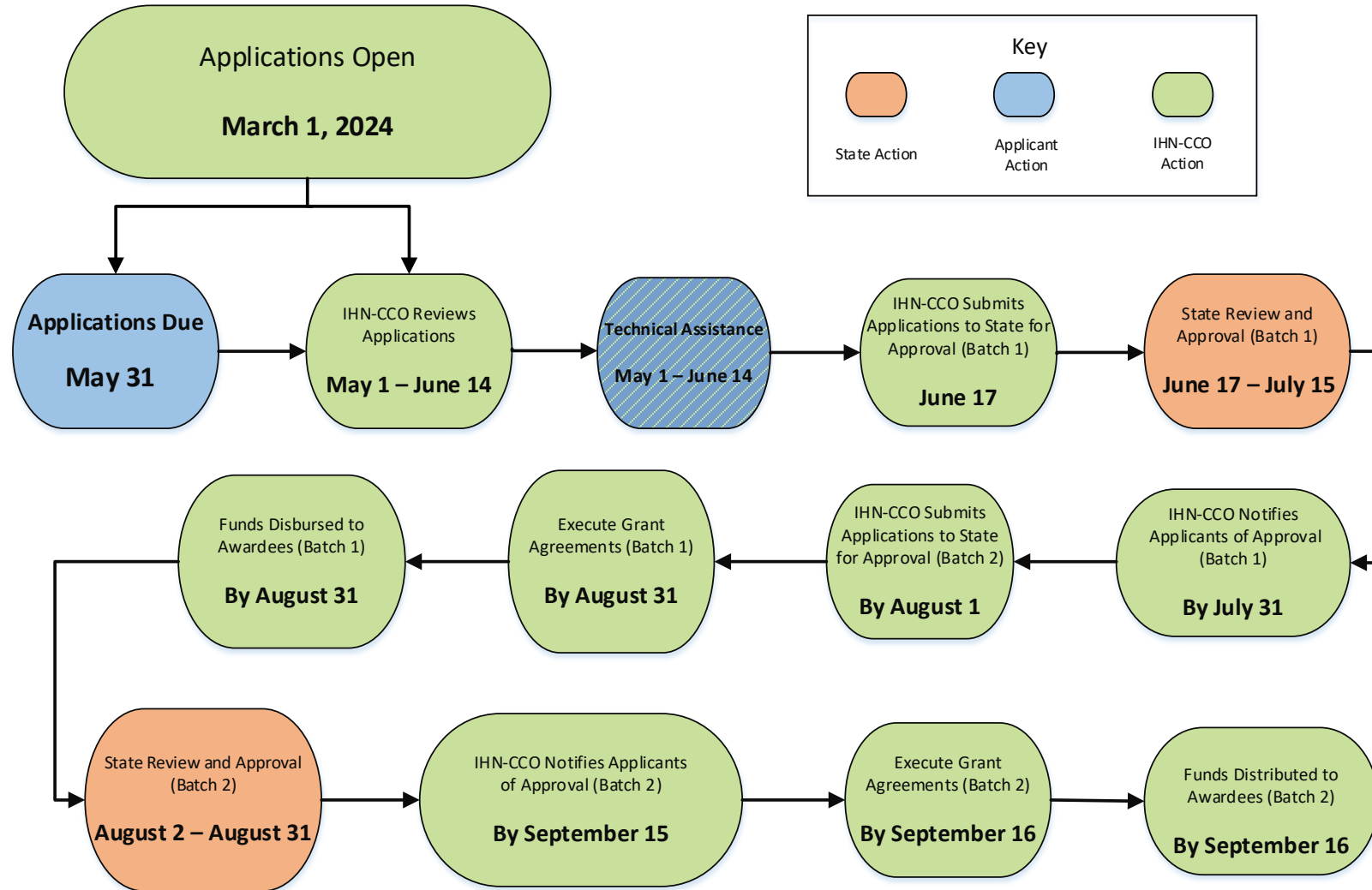
