



Parents, don't let your child get left behind!

Oregon law requires vaccines for school and child care attendance based on a child's age. When following the recommended vaccine schedule, these are the vaccines your child should receive.*



A child 2-17 months old entering
child care or early education
is due for

**Varies. Check with your child's
healthcare and daycare provider.**

A child 18 months or older entering
preschool, child care or Head Start*
is due for

**4th Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis (DTaP)
3rd Polio
1st Varicella (chickenpox)
1st Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR)
3rd Hepatitis B
2nd Hepatitis A
3rd/4th Hib**

A student entering
Kindergarten*
is due for

**5th and final dose of DTaP
4th and final dose of Polio
2nd and final dose of MMR
2nd and final dose of Varicella**

A student entering
7th grade*
is due for

1 Tdap Booster (for school)
Also recommended: HPV and
Meningococcal
